To: ALL New Hampshire Masons
Brethren,

The "Stay Safer at Home" Order issued by the Governor of the State of New Hampshire commenced on June 15, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby issue the following updated guidance in Lodge activities within this Jurisdiction. My EDICT remains in effect. As such, any duly elected and installed Worshipful Master of any Lodge in this Grand Jurisdiction may continue to cancel any regular Stated Communication of his Lodge for reasons specific to the COVID-19 Virus.

The phased re-entry plan is updated as follows:

Phase I commenced on June 15, 2020 and applies to Stated Communications and Special Communications.

Phase IA commenced on June 19, 2020 and applies to Inspections and rehearsals.

Effective, July 1, 2020, Lodge Visitations may be convened.

Phase IB commenced on July 15, 2020 and applies to meals and collations subject to set guidelines.

Phase II commenced on August 1, 2020 and applies to the conducting of Degrees.

Today I am announcing the final phase of our Masonic re-entry plan - Phase III commences on September 1, 2020 and pertains to the holding of Veterans and Special Ladies Programs. Lodges may again host Veterans and Special Ladies Programs so long as they conform to local, state and Federal guidelines related to the COVID-19 virus.

While this pandemic remains a threat, we must be diligent in the practice of social distancing, wearing of masks and frequent hygiene. I will continue to update the membership if pandemic conditions change in this Jurisdiction.

I wish to thank the many Brethren of this Grand Jurisdiction for their patience and flexibility as we navigate the turbulent waters of this pandemic. At all times, the health and safety of our membership was and is front and center. Stay safe and enjoy your
